# The Seven Pillars of World Economic Dominance

Each pillar is a complete national programme: measurable, indigenous and accountable. Together they form the architecture of dominance.

## Pillar I

### National Cultural Reengineering Programme

Through God and God related ventures. Restoration of identity, values and purposeful citizenship as the bedrock of every other reform.

## Pillar II

### Exploration, Repossession and Harnessing of Resources

Of all our natural and human resources for national development. A full audit of national assets, legal repossession, and indigenous capacity to harness them.

## Pillar III

### National Consumption Containment Policy

Ending dependency on allied nations. Local production gains primacy; imports are contained and re engineered toward sovereign supply chains.

## Pillar IV

### Sixth Industrial Revolutionary Adventures

Production, distribution and exportation through Naija made science. Mass production capacity that turns Nigeria into a net exporter.

## Pillar V

### Re Institution of Naija Made Science and Technology

For health, education, engineering and ICT. National engineering schools, innovation funds and applied research embedded in every classroom and lab.

# **National Infrastructural Development and Civil Construction**

Rail, roads, waterways and the digital backbone. Re invention and re innovation of civic infrastructure as a permanent national project.

## **Pillar VII**

### **Re establishment of Taxable Social Amenities**

Power, rail, roads, waterways, internet, networks, mobile devices and transportation. A grid of accountable, revenue generating public utilities.

## **Plan 3 • State by State Visit and National Tour**

## **Plan 4 • Unveiling of NLM, Liberty App and Leadership**

Public unveiling of the movement, the Liberty App platform and the emerging leadership cohort.

## **Plan 5 • Budget of Liberty**

Activation of the ₦77.7 Billion mobilisation fund across the seven pillars.

## **Plan 6 • Shadow Government**

Standing up the Shadow Government to mirror, audit and reform every arm of national administration.

## **Plan 7 • Liberation Field Officer Deployment**

Three Liberation Field Officers per polling unit, totalling 540,000 officers across 180,000 polling units.
